2008 DORSET COUNTY DEVELOPMENT COMPETITION

Under ASA Laws and Technical Rules

All Clubs, coaches and competitors should carefully read the information given below before completion of entry forms. This sheet should be retained for future reference.

General Conditions:

1. The current Dorset County ASA General Competition Conditions will apply as printed in the ASA SouthWest Region ASA Handbook, unless inconsistent with the conditions which follow. All entrants must accept these conditions.
2. Swimmers competing in any other County Championship or Age Group Competition are NOT eligible to compete in any Dorset County Integrated BAGCats, Championship or Age Group Competition (the Competitions), or any event covered by the Dorset General Competition Conditions.
3. The following conditions will apply to Swimmers Entries:
 - a. All competitors must have an ASA registration number. No entry will be accepted without the swimmer's current ASA registration number.
 - b. Swimmers with a Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability may enter the Competition.
 - c. ASA or IPC Official Times MUST be submitted for all individual events entered.
 - d. ASA/IPC Official Times must have been achieved in an event held under ASA Laws and Technical Rules or IPC Rules from which an individual Official Time has been recorded.
 - e. All submitted entries must be made using Short Course times. Conversion of Long Course times is permitted.
 - f. Non-ASA or IPC Official Times will not be accepted.
 - g. ASA or IPC Official Times outside of Ranx will not be accepted without the event and date at which the Official Time was achieved being declared.
 - h. All ASA/IPC Official Times MUST be certified by an officer of the swimmer's club.
 - i. Entries received will be subject to satisfying the qualifying standards as specified in the Competition or, if space permits, the consideration standard. Entry times outside of the consideration standard will not be accepted. (Swimmers with a Functional Ability Card or a Certificate of Swimming Disability, see Entry Conditions clause 5c of the 2008 Entry Conditions & Information for exceptions.)
 - j. Entries will be seeded on submitted times, the slowest time swimming first.
 - k. The Promoter may request validation of any stated ASA or IPC Official entry time.
 - l. All Ranx entries must comply with 3(a-g) above. Non-Ranx entries from Clubs not using Ranx must ensure that the conditions stated at 3(a-g) above are given fully. Any entries not complying with 3(a-g) above or are found to be incorrect shall be void and the entry fee forfeited.
4. All official entry times submitted must have been achieved between the first day of the preceding year's Integrated BAGCats, Championships and Age Group Competition and the applicable closing date of this year's Competition. Submitted entry times achieved outside of this specified period will not be accepted.
5. All entries must come from the Club Entries Officer and not individuals and enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope to enable entries to be acknowledged.
6. Entry for members of Clubs using Ranx will be by invitation in advance of the closing date. On receipt of Ranx data, Clubs will receive a schedule of invited entries for swimmers with ranked times in accordance with clauses 3(a-g) and 4 above, and the stated qualifying/consideration times. Ranx Clubs Entries Officers are required to confirm invited entries with the Meet Co-ordinator by the appropriate closing date of the Competitions.
7. All Clubs will receive a schedule of accepted entries prior to the Competition, the details of which should be checked and any discrepancy notified to the Meet Co-ordinator immediately. Any rejected entries will be listed. Swimmers who are not listed on the official confirmation of accepted entries will not be permitted to compete.

8. The Competition will run with pre-seeded heats according to clause 3(j) of the General Conditions. No entry cards will be issued and no secondary registration on the day is required. Empty lanes due to withdrawals on the day will remain vacant.
9. Failure to appear in the designated heat will cancel any right to compete in that event. Swimmers may be allowed to swim in unallocated lanes in the same event at the Referee's discretion. This shall be on a first-come first-served basis.
10. All competitors will be placed with the exception of any swimmer disqualified.
11. Requests for Time Trials will not be accepted at any time.
12. Improved entry times will not be accepted at any time.
13. All entries must be received by the applicable closing date as a whole Club entry together with the correct entry fee and, if appropriate, the administration fee. A single cheque payable to Dorset County ASA must be sent with each Club's entry. No entries will be accepted after the applicable closing date.
14. Entries submitted without the correct entry fee, entry forms, administration fee and health declarations incorrectly completed where applicable will be returned.
15. ONLY CLUBS WITHOUT ACCESS TO THE RANX SYSTEM MAY SUBMIT PAPER ENTRIES. Clubs with access to Ranx that submit paper entries will be subject to an administration fee of £10 for 50 or less paper entries and £10 for every 50 paper entries thereafter.
16. A single cheque will be made for any refunds due for rejected entries to the Clubs after the completion of the competition.
17. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the closing date unless on medical grounds for which a doctor's certificate will be required.
18. The Official Promoter of the Competition is the Dorset County ASA Swimming Committee through Mr. John Bolton. The Swimming Committee has set all conditions of the Competition and any enquiries in the first instance should be directed to the Promoter via the swimmer's Club Entries Officer, as follows: John Bolton, 5 Stanfield Road, Ferndown, Dorset BH22 9PA. 19. The Swimming Committee has delegated the running of the event to a Meet Co-ordinator. Entries should be sent to the Meet Co-ordinator by the applicable closing date, as follows: Di Gibbs, 22 Stibbs Way, Bransgore, Christchurch, Dorset BH23 8HG.
20. The dates and events for the programme of this year's Dorset County Development Competition are as printed on the 2008 Entry Conditions & Information sheet enclosed.
21. The Promoter reserves the right to alter or amend the Programme. In the event of any major alteration Clubs will be informed accordingly.
22. All competitors, coaches, team managers and spectators are required to observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves appropriately and with safety in mind at all times within the hired facility. Doors will be open and warm up will start approximately 45 minutes before the gala is due to commence. Swimmers will not enter the hired area until the Referee shall give permission. The Referee is responsible for all aspects of health and safety in the area hired by DCASA and can halt the competition at any time if there are any perceived risks to health and safety of competitors, officials or spectators.
23. Any swimmer or coach requiring wheelchair access MUST ensure that the relevant leisure centre approves this in advance and a personal evacuation plan agreed and submitted to the Promoter for passing to the Referee prior to the start of the gala.
24. It is the responsibility of each Club's Committee to ensure that their Coach, Team Managers and Warm-Up/Warm-Down Marshals are responsible for their swimmers on the poolside, including behaviour, dress and code of conduct at all times.
25. The use of the warm-down facility (if provided) is made available to swimmers ONLY if supervised by one of their Club officials with an accredited poolside pass. The facility will be withdrawn if the use is unsupervised or if deemed to be a risk to health and safety.
26. In line with recommendations in the ASA Child Protection Policy, the Promoter of this event requests that any persons wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography registers their details with DCASA Staff at the spectator entry desk before carrying out such photography. The leisure centre may have its own local regulations on this subject, which may supersede this condition and must be complied with. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave the spectator gallery/poolside.
27. Dorset County ASA reserves the right to take and publish photographs during presentations. Any request not to be photographed MUST be documented on the swimmer's Health Information Form and be received by the Promoter before the Competition commences.

Dorset County ASA Development Competition 2008

Entry Conditions & Information

1. Dates

- a. **Competition:** Saturday 5 July and Sunday 6 July 2008
- b. **Closing dates:**
 - i) Entries - Saturday 8 June 2008
 - ii) Ranx data - Saturday 27 April 2008 + closing date

2. Age Groups

- a. Age groups will be based on age on the last day of the competition.
- b. Age groups will be based on age as at 6 July 2008.
- c. Age groups will be:
A - 9 (M/F); B - 10 (M/F); C - 11 (M/F); D - 12 (M/F);
E - 13 (M/F); F - 14 (M/F); G - 15 (M/F); H - 16/o (M/F)

3. Entry Fees

- a. All events £5.00 per event.
- b. All Clubs submitting multiple entries submit one cheque per block of entries.
- c. Cheques must be made payable to DORSET COUNTY ASA.

4. Events

As a requirement for the ASA to grant a license for this Competition, all events and distances are as defined by the ASA.

5. Entry Times

This event is a Level 3 Licensed Meet and therefore subject to consideration times and upper cut-off times.

a. Upper Cut-off Times

Swimmers entering this Competition must not have achieved a time that is faster than the time indicated in the Entry Times schedule. Entry times that exceed the upper Cut-off Times indicated will be rejected. The upper Cut-off Times used for this competition are those Qualifying Times set for the WCASA Youth and Age Group Championships 2008. For age groups and events not included in those Championships, Cut-off Times have been defined using the ASA's Qualifying Times Generation Programme for Regional Competition. Any swimmer that exceeds the upper Cut-off Time during the competition will not be disqualified from that event.

b. Consideration Times

The Consideration Times for this competition have been defined using the ASA's Qualifying Times Generation Programme for Licensed Meets. These entries will be accepted into the competition as time permits. Entry times outside the consideration standard will not be accepted. (See Entry Conditions clause 5c for exceptions).

c. Swimmers with a registered Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability

- i) Swimmers with a registered functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability may submit entries and will be accepted as time permits as part of the overall competition.
- ii) The times submitted may be outside the consideration times for other swimmers. Swimmers will compete in the appropriate time ranked heat.
- iii) The details of Functional Ability/Disability classification should be declared along with an entry time. The card or certificate must be presented to the Referee before any swim to which it applies.

d. Male/Female 400m Freestyle events

- i) Acceptance of entries in these events will be restricted to swimmers with the fastest submitted times. The maximum number of heats in each of the combined events will be limited by the time available.
- ii) The 400m Freestyle will be swum as mixed time-seeded heats for Under/12s and 12/Overs with the fastest eight males and eight females in each age band being guaranteed acceptance. Thereafter acceptance for each sex will be based on percentage proximity to the upper cut-off time.
- iii) Awards for these events will be made in accordance with Clause 10(a) of the 2008 Entry Conditions & Information.

e. Entry Times

- i) Submitted times must have been achieved within the specified period of 10 February 2007 to 8 June 2008.
- ii) Requests for time trials WILL NOT be accepted either before or on the day of the gala. (See clause 11 of the General Conditions).
- iii) Improved entry times WILL NOT be accepted at any time. (See clause 12 of the General Conditions).

6. Health Declaration

To ensure adequate safety procedures and protocols are observed, and the safety and well being of all swimmers, all associated medical conditions must be declared on a Health Information Form together with the management plan for the condition. These conditions include, but are not limited to: asthma, seizures, epilepsy, diabetes, low blood pressure, cardiac abnormalities and tendency to hyperventilate. The Declaration shall be made by the swimmer/parent/guardian for the sole use of those persons with responsibility for health and safety during the Competition. The content of the declaration will remain confidential. Any swimmer who did not compete in the Dorset County Integrated BAGCats, Championships and Age Group Competition 2008 must complete a Health Information Form. Health Information Forms of those swimmers who did compete in the 2008 Competitions will be held on file until completion of the Dorset County Development Competition 2008.

7. Competitors Declaration Form

The forms of those swimmers who did compete in the Dorset County Integrated BAGCats, Championships and Age Group Competition 2008 will be held on file until completion of the Dorset County Development Competition 2008. A Dorset ASA Competitors Declaration Form must be submitted for all swimmers who did not compete in the 2008 Competitions.

8. Heat Declared Events

All events will be Heat Declared Winner (HDW). There will be no Finals.

9. Skins

Entry to Skins events will be offered to the fastest eight swimmers of the 50m Freestyle and 50m Backstroke events. Swimmers must confirm with the Recorders Desk their intent to compete or withdraw from the Skins by the end of the session in which the heat swim took place. Failure to confirm intent to compete in the Skins within the allotted time will mean that swimmer is automatically withdrawn from the event and a reserve swimmer called as a replacement.

10. Awards & Presentations

a. HDW Events

- i) Age Group medals will be awarded for first, second and third places in each of the designated Age Groups.
- ii) For swimmers presenting a Functional Ability Card or a Certificate of Swimming Disability medals will be awarded for first, second and third placed swimmers in each age group provided there are at least four swimmers. Where only three swimmers compete, first and second place shall be awarded and should there be only two swimmers, first place only shall be awarded. The promoter reserves the right to vary these conditions if appropriate. The order of finish will be determined by the relative position to the World Record for the relevant Functional Ability category.
- iii) Swimmers may collect Age Group medals from the Presentation Table once the results have been announced. There will be no formal presentation of Age Group medals.

b. Skins

Medals will be awarded for first, second and third places and ribbons awarded to 4th to 8th place. Awards will be presented immediately after the event.

c. Individual awards

- i) An award for the 'Fastest Girl of the Day' and 'Fastest Boy of the Day' based on GB(BAG) points for the single fastest swim will be presented at the end of each day of the Competition.
- ii) An award for the 'Most Improved Girl' and 'Most Improved Boy' based on the highest percentage improvement on submitted time for an event as specified below will be presented at the end of the Competition for the following categories:
 - Most Improved Distance Swimmer (400m Freestyle)
 - Most Improved Middle Distance Swimmer (200m Freestyle)
 - Most Improved Medley Swimmer (100m or 200m Individual Medley)
 - Most Improved Form Swimmer (200m Breaststroke or Backstroke or Butterfly)
 - Most Improved Sprinter (50m or 100m events)

d. Club awards

- i) A trophy for 'Top Development Club' calculated from Club Team Points will be presented at the end of the Competition.
- ii) A trophy for 'Most Improved Club' calculated from the average percentage improvement of the total number of entries of each Club will be presented at the end of the Competition.

11. Club Team Points

Points will be awarded to all individual swimmers placed first to eighth in their respective Age Groups as follows: 1st place = 8 points descending to 1 point = 8th place. Team Points will be displayed at strategic times throughout the Competition. Where a swimmer has dual recognition, he/she may represent only one Club. This shall be the Club named on the entry form.

12. Code of Conduct

All swimmers shall comply with the DCASA Code of Conduct and the County further reserves the right to take any disciplinary action against the swimmer(s) concerned and/or the swimmers' Clubs.

13. Poolside personnel

Only duly authorised personnel, and including any person accompanying a swimmer with a Functional Ability Card or Certificate of Swimming Disability, who are registered on the

ASA/Clubs Child Protection Lists and competitors shall be allowed poolside.

14. Spectators

Entry will be free and subject to the limit of accommodation at the respective venue. There will be a charge of £3.00 for spectator programmes.
